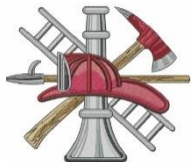


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The Clovis Unified Firefighting Technology program is part of the Public Safety Pathway based at Clovis East High School. It offers a realistic opportunity to learn about and experience a career in the Fire Service.

Course Description:

Firefighting Technology 1 and 2 is reserved for junior and senior high school students. Students taking the course for the second year are considered to be Firefighting Technology 2 students. They will have an enhanced leadership role within the class, and be expected to assist the instructor with a variety of tasks.

This pathway is intended to prepare students, both mentally and physically, to pursue a career in the Fire Service. The framework is designed around skills students will be required to demonstrate in an actual Firefighter 1 entry level fire academy. Passing this course does not automatically grant the student certification; however, it is intended to help prepare the student of the Firefighter 1 certification process. Students should be prepared to participate in rigorous physical activity and expect to be exposed to a variety of physically and emotionally challenging situations. As a critical component of the curriculum, this class will adopt an increased level of classroom structure and individual discipline.

Pathway Courses:

10th Grade: Emergency Medical Response
(Only available to Clovis East students)

11th & 12th Grade: Firefighting Technology 1

12th Grade: Firefighting Technology 1 & 2

Note: 11th and 12th grade students taking Fire Tech for the first year will be enrolled in Fire Tech 1. 12th Grade students taking Fire Tech for the second year will be enrolled in Fire Tech 2.
