





If you have never taken a college course you will be creating a new account with CCCApply.



If you have taken community college classes before, you will log in to the account with the info you used when you first applied. You can't create a new one so you if you forgot your info, click on the Forgot? tab for the info.

Create Your OpenCCC Account

OpenCCC allows you to access California Community Colleges secure web applications.

You Must Have an Email Address

The California Community Colleges and OpenCCC will use email to send you important information. You will need to provide an email address when you create your account.

Make sure you use a personal email, not your school email to ensure you have access to your account after graduation.

Social Security Number

Just Remember...

Providing a social security number or taxpayer identification number is not required with respect to non-U.S. resident students (whether documented or undocumented), students taking noncredit courses, students whose qualified tuition and related expenses are waived or paid with scholarships or paid by an institutional third party including an employer or government agency. (26 C.F.R. § 1.6050S-1.) A SSN or TIN/iTIN is not required when IRS reporting is not required.

Check this box if you are a student enrolled exclusively in noncredit courses, an undocumented student, an international student, a nonresident alien, or another exception and do not have a social security number or taxpayer identification number.

If you HAVE a social security number (SSN) enter it here without the dashes. Continue creating your account.

If you do not know your SSN and need to get it from your parents, click the "No" option and you can add this number in at a later time. Continue creating your account.




How to Apply for Financial Aid

Fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aide (FAFSA) if you are a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident at FAFSA.gov.

Fill out the California Dream Act (CADAA) if you are an undocumented, AB540 eligible student at dream.csac.ca.gov.

Apply between Oct 1 – March 2




Create an Account if you have never setup an FSA ID and then select 'Get Started'

Federal Student Aide ID (FSA ID) for FAFSA

- Required to electronically sign FAFSA.
- If you are a dependent student, one parent must also create their own unique FSA ID.



Step #2: Enter Account Information. Use a personal email address (not CUSD email).






Step #3: Enter Contact Information
