## WHAT IS **NET PRICE?**HOW DO I KNOW WHAT I'LL PAY?

Net price is the amount that a student pays to attend an institution in a single academic year AFTER subtracting scholarships and grants the student receives. Scholarships and grants are forms of financial aid that a student DOES NOT have to pay back. Some students only pay \$3,472 to attend CSU Fullerton, not the \$27,343 sticker price

### **QUESTIONS**

Graduation rates are for four-year colleges only. The average graduation rate and transfer rates at two-year colleges is less than 30%. Fewer than three in 10 students who go to a community college complete a degree or transfer.

Some colleges help students better than others, so graduation rates are not the same across schools or student groups.

A fee waiver removes the cost of applying to a 4-year college. Turn the page to figure out how to apply for fee waivers.











Complete the "My Application" and "Add Program" sections.





Once you have fully completed the application, you will see the "Check My Fee Waiver Status" link. Click on the link to determine your eligibility.





Avoid common errors that may cause you **not to receive** an application fee waiver:

- If you report yourself as a dependent applicant with a family size of one.
- 2. If you report the same dollar amount in the Adjusted Gross Income field as well as in the Untaxed Income field.
- 3. If you select "none" in answer to "What U.S. State/
  Possession do you regard as your permanent home?"


## FEE WAIVER




In the "About you" section of the application, complete the "Family Size & Income" accurately and completely. You cannot go back and change this answer and apply for the fee waiver again.





During the submission process, click "APPLY FOR A FEE WAIVER" During the submission process, once and the system will [Step 6 of the Review & Submit section] and the system will the waiver if you are eligible. automatically grant the waiver if you are eligible.





If you don't get a fee waiver, talk to your counselor because you have other options through College Board. Select the "Check (by mail)" Other Options Illiough College Doubles Courselor about sending a College
payment option and talk to your counselor about sending a College Board waiver with the application receipt to the UC Application Center or submitting submit a letter with your receipt explaining your situation. Fee waivers may be granted for special circumstances on a case-by-case basis.
