

# Frequently Asked Questions about Returning to School

## Hybrid Model (Combination of Face to Face and Online Learning)

**1. Why are students placed in track A or track B?**

Due to social distancing guideline, students on the hybrid model are placed on either track A or B because classrooms can only accommodate up to 16 students.

**2. Can students switch track?**

Track assignment was determined by the student's address to keep all siblings together and on the same schedule. There are many variables such as classroom capacity, specialty courses, and staffing issues that make switching track not possible.

**3. Will my student's class schedule or teacher change with the hybrid model?**

Yes, it is likely that many students will have schedule and/or teacher changes.

**4. What is Homeroom?**

Homeroom is a class period for students to check-in with their 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> period teachers on the days that they don't have class on campus.

**5. Does the hybrid model allow my student to keep CART, AP, CTE or ROP classes?**

It is our goal to keep students in their specialty classes. Counselors will reach out to specific students as needed.

**6. How much learning time will students have with each teacher per week?**

Students will see each teacher twice a week for a total of 135 minutes.

## Expectations for parents & students on the hybrid model

**1. What are the health and safety procedures to keep my student safe?**

Parents will do a health screening before sending their student to school. Students will check-in with a staff member to get their temperature taken prior to entering campus. Signage will be posted inside buildings and around campus to direct the flow of traffic and keep students socially distanced. Classrooms will be sanitized during each passing period.

**2. Do students have to wear their masks all day?**

Yes, masks are required for students and staff members when on campus. Masks must be worn properly following the health and safety guidelines.

**3. Can students interact with their teachers, classmates and friends?**

Interactions are allowed but must abide by the 6ft social distancing and mask guidelines.

**4. What are students doing on the days they are not on campus?**

In the morning, students are expected to complete their assigned Google Classroom activities independently and join the homeroom teacher via Zoom after lunch.

## Transportation & Meals

Buses and meals will be available to students who select the hybrid model.

## **CUSD Connect Model (Scheduled Online Learning)**

**1. Will my student's class schedule or teacher change with the CUSD Connect model?**

Yes, it is likely that many students will have a schedule or a teacher changes.

**2. Does the CUSD Connect model allow my student to keep CART, AP, CTE or ROP classes?**

It is our goal to keep students in their specialty classes. Counselors will reach out to specific students as needed.

**3. How much learning time will students have with each teacher per week?**

Students will see each teacher three times a week for a total of 225 minutes.

## **Co-curricular Participation**

**Can students participate in sports, performing arts, academic teams and clubs if they stay on CUSD Connect?**

Yes, students can participate in co-curricular activities in both Hybrid and CUSD Connect models.
