Students do **NOT** need to take the SAT or ACT if they are going directly to a community college or are applying to a **UC** school. The **CSU** system has temporarily suspended the ACT/SAT requirement for Fall 2022 admission. Students should check SAT/ACT requirements if they are applying to a **private** or **out-of-state** college/university.

Planning to join the military after you graduate from high school?

Meet with a recruiter, take the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB), learn about the ROTC scholarship and visit the [Military page](#) on our website.
