Students do **NOT** need to take the SAT or ACT if they are going directly to a community college or are applying to a **UC or CSU** school. Students should check SAT/ACT requirements if they are applying to a **private** or **out-of-state** college/university, or if they are planning on playing sports in college (NCAA and/or NAIA)

Planning to join the military after you graduate from high school?

Meet with a recruiter, take the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB), learn about the ROTC scholarship and visit the Military page on our website. The ASVAB will be administered at Buchanan on November 9, 2023 from 8:00 a.m. to Noon. Recruiters from each branch of the military are available virtually throughout the school year.
